



East Central Adult League Registrar information

League Format:

- Coed
 - This league is a coed league. **There are gender requirements for the number of females per team.** (See Updated League Rules Section below)
- Divisions
 - If participation numbers allow, the league will be divided into divisions based on level of play as reported by the clubs.

League Administration:

- Administration
 - The East Central Adult League will be administered by the East Central Soccer District and the Adult League Commissioner.
 - Registration
 - Players must register through East Central clubs who are affiliated with the Wisconsin Soccer Leagues (WSL). Individual clubs will be responsible for their players and team's administration and behavior just as they are in the youth leagues.
 - No unregistered WSL players may participate.
 - Last day to add adult players to the roster is June 15th.
 - Youth players
 - For a youth player to be eligible to be rostered in the adult league, the player-must have completed their junior year in high school or apply for a waiver through the district.
 - A youth player that is rostered on and participating in an East Central youth league (rec or classic) in a WYSA state or WDA league or Region II MRL league who wishes to play on an adult team must register to a WSL adult roster.
 - PLEASE NOTE: Youth players that register on the adult league will be charged for WSL adult player fees and East Central adult fees in addition to WYSA and East Central youth fees.
 - WSL Club/Team Setup - StackSports is the Registration and Scheduling tool
 - Clubs will contact East Central by early March should they wish to have an adult League team considered for scheduling.
 - Each club registering adult players must have a separate WSL account for adult registration.
 - You cannot register adult players under the youth database. See rules about High School players.
 - Clubs must provide:

- Registration fee per player. WSL will take out set dollar amount for insurance and administrative cost. Balance will be returned to club before the start of the season.
 - Fields
 - Jersey Color
 - Team Name(s)
 - Coach
 - Team Manager
 - Level of play: Low Recreational or High Recreational

- Rosters
 - Rosters-Players must be listed on a WSL team roster.
 - WSL will provide the club with a roster before the start of the season. If additional players are added to the roster after start of season, the club will request a new roster from WSL.
 - Rosters must be presented to the official at game time. Player photos will be located at the bottom of the roster. **Players will provide a photo id at the start of the game instead of using the traditional player pass cards.**
 - Rosters should have a minimum of 12 registered players for teams to be considered for scheduling.
 - Rosters must have at least 14 players prior to the start of league play.
- Scheduling
 - Number of games:
 - Each team will be scheduled for 8 games
 - No games will be scheduled the Sunday closest to the 4th of July, however teams may use that date to reschedule games if both teams agree and the referee assignor agrees.
 - Start Times:
 - Primarily between 5 and 7:00 pm but League game times will be flexible. Both teams must agree.
 - Process:
 - WSL will provide periodic updates to the club on the number of players registered.
 - Clubs will have an opportunity to reassign players to other teams before the final roster is created.
 - A preliminary draft of the schedule will be provided.
 - Final schedule will be posted in May. See scheduling timeline.
 - Any changes after the final schedule is posted must follow the East Central rescheduling guidelines.

League Rules:

• Gender Rule

- There must be two (2) female players on the field at all times. If at any time a team does not have two (2) female players on the field that team will play down the number of female players missing:
 - If at any time a team only has one (1) female on the field that team will only be allowed 10 players total on the field.

- If at any time a team has zero (0) female players on the field, that team will only be allowed 9 players total on the field.
 - If BOTH TEAMS have zero (0) female players, the game may be played 11v11 as long as no female players present.
- **Minimum Roster Rule**
 - Rosters should have a minimum of 12 players to be included in the scheduling for the season.
 - Final Rosters must have at least 14 players prior to the start of League play.
- **Game Rescheduling and Postponing Procedures**
 - Adult teams must follow the same procedure as the Classic and Recreational leagues.

No player passes need to be sent in for Red Cards - teams will monitor their red cards & player sits at least the next East Central League Game. Referees will fill out the red card report form in Game Officials within 12 hours after completion of the game.

Unlimited club pass players at the Adult level games as long as the players are registered as adults

Every game should begin with a coin toss by the Referee with visiting team call it. Team winning coin toss selects goal they will attack, losing team will kick off.

Gender Rule- There must be two (2) female players on the field at all times. If at any time a team does not have two (2) female players on the field that team will play down the number of female players missing:

If at any time a team only has one (1) female on the field that team will only be allowed 10 players total on the field.

If at any time a team has zero (0) female players on the field, that team will only be allowed 9 players total on the field.

If BOTH TEAMS have zero (0) female players, the game may be played 11v11 as long as no female players present.
